Superior Court Judge Eugene Hyman "Early Intervention Program for Domestic Violence"

Judge Eugene M. Hyman is a judge of the Superior Court of California, County of Santa Clara (San Jose) where, for 18 years, he has presided over cases in the criminal, civil, probate, family, and delinquency divisions of the court.

He has presided over an adult domestic violence court and in 1999 presided over the first juvenile domestic violence and family violence court in the United States.



Judge Hyman has spoken to both national and international audiences and has published articles on issues surrounding domestic violence in the criminal and family courts -- especially with co-occurring issues of substance abuse and mental health. He has a special interest in domestic violence as it affects children in the home and in the family court setting. He has special understanding of sexual abuse, stalking, and strangulation, as they intersect with domestic violence.

Judge Hyman taught as a Lecturer in Law at the Santa Clara University School of Law for 21 years where he has taught a course "Domestic Violence Law Seminar" for the past several years.

On June 23, 2008, **Eugene Hyman**, '77, Judge, and the State of California Superior Court for the County of Santa Clara was honored with the United Nations Public Service Award.


